Roy was appointed "warden" of Woodrow High House in 1984 having been a fully qualified Youth & Community Worker graduating in Liverpool in 1968. Previously he had worked as a youth & community worker in Slough, London and Nottingham. Roy then arrived at Woodrow to set up a new vocational training programme and training centre for 120 "unemployable" young people.

As a former member of a Boys Club in London and elsewhere, Roy undertook a considerable number of training and development opportunities through his club life which eventually led him to an increasingly rewarding career in youth work.

Over the years Roy has served on numerous committees and has chaired many diverse groups including the Fulham Youth Festival – Cystic Fibrosis Holiday Fund.

Having been a cabaret singer in his youth, Roy enjoys Big Band/Swing Music and still occasionally performs for charity. He is a Fulham football supporter and maintains a keen interest in many sports and the performing arts.
